4th August – Theft of specialist machinery 'Head Rope Attachment' from the Anglo-american Woodsmith site at Sneatonthorpe, where it was being stored until its deployment in the winding house. The item was found on York Auction Centre's site, serial number and engineering drawing confirmed it was the correct piece of machinery. The item was withdrawn from the auction and moved to a secure site. Timeframe for theft is not known, and there are no suspects at this time. The auctioneers, company and police are liaising and enquiries are on-going.
