Crime/Incident Breakdown

Hinderwell Parish:

5th July – On-going issue with ASB on Cliff Road, Staithes. Motorbikes using a private track. Possible CCTV.

7th July -The EV charging unit in Top Lane Car Park, Runswick Bay has been vandalised with pink paint and parts removed.

13th July – Male is seen shooting seagulls with an air rifle from his attic window. The dead seagulls are in front of his property. Potential wildlife offences, passed to rural task force to follow up.

Mickleby, Ugthorpe and Roxby Parishes:

20th July – Possible attempted burglary/dog snatching at Postgate Way Ugthorpe. All the doors were closed but the puppy was found in the carpark and a vehicle was seen speeding away. There isn't any CCTV. No further action at present.

Hawsker and Sneaton Parishes:

7th July – The defibrillator has been stolen from its box on the wall of The Windmill Inn. No lines of enquiry.

Fylingdales Parishes:

25th July – Report a male on the X93 bus to Scarborough has pulled a kitchen knife on a teenage boy. No threats were made and the knife was put in the male's bag. Parent and son left the bus at the Flask Inn. Police attend and board the bus, 1 male searched and arrested for possession of a weapon.

Newholm, Aislaby and Lythe Parishes:

25th July – The X93 bus stopped at Aislaby on A171 due to an altercation between 2 males on the upper deck. Passengers were transferred to another bus. Police attend and stop/check 1 male. Both males blame each other, no complaints, parties were separated and departed on different buses.

5th July – A barn at Fryup Lodge has been broken into but nothing was stolen.

2nd July – Several reports of suspicious behaviour in the Comondale area. Up to 10 persons on 4 quad bikes riding around the area, checking houses and farms. Driving off road in the direction of Lealholm. Police units close to the border have been made aware.

11th July – Theft of 36 railway sleepers from outside business premises on Potters Side Lane. They were stolen sometime between 1st and 11th of July. No lines of enquiry.
